(INDIANAPOLIS) - The Indiana Beef Cattle Association (IBCA) is now accepting applications for the 3rd annual Sennett Farms Cattle Company Scholarship. The \$500 scholarship is being made possible through the generous donation of Clark Sennett, owner of Sennett Farms Cattle Company in Waynetown, IN. Applicants must be from a family that is actively involved in beef production and are current IBCA members. In addition, applicants must be residents of Indiana who are an existing college student majoring in agriculture or a high school senior planning to major in agriculture.

In order to apply, candidates must complete an application form and write an original essay about: *"A Significant Challenge to the Beef Industry"*. Essays will be judged on the basis of clarity of expression, persuasiveness, originality and relevance of the topic. A winner will be announced in by July 1st. IBCA reserves the right to publish any or all parts of the essays submitted.
