# **SUBMISSION GUIDELINES**

**Applicant Requirements:** School transcripts (last 4 years); list of high school or college activities, clubs and organizations; list of community service involvement; 2 letters of recommendation.

**Applicants must submit written answers to the following four questions  
Maximum 200 words per question.**

- 1. How has your participation in the beef industry prepared you for life?**
- 2. Where do you see yourself in five years?**
- 3. How will your career ambitions benefit the beef industry?**
- 4. How do you plan to promote the beef industry in your future career?**

**Producer committees of the Indiana Beef Cattle Association will administer the program, judge the essays and select the winners. The winning applicant will be determined based on clarity of expression, originality and relevance.**

**Scholarship recipients must complete the NCBA Masters of Beef Advocacy (MBA) program, an e-learning opportunity developed to assist producers across the country in becoming effective spokespersons for the industry.**

**Scholarship Payment will be made upon proof of completion of the next immediate grading period and MBA program. Proof of completion must be submitted to the IBCA office within 30 days of said period. Payment will be made to student and the institution.**

**All applications must be postmarked no later than March 31, 2019. The scholarship(s) will be awarded during the 2019 Indiana State Fair Grand Drive *and* the Indiana Junior Beef Cattle Association Awards Banquet.**
