



Purpose of Beef IN the Classroom

Beef IN the classroom is a grant program funded by the Indiana Beef Council in partnership with Indiana's beef farmers and ranchers who pay the beef checkoff. This program is designed to add financial assistance for classrooms to use beef & beef products in their lesson plans. Our goal is to teach young adults about the cattle industry and beef!

Reimbursement Program

To receive reimbursement for beef you will need to submit a receipt.

This program is limited to \$100 per teacher per year towards the purchase of beef.

Reimbursement will be given after all documents are returned to the Indiana Beef Council by **May 31, 2024**

Application

Complete the application online.

Recipients must fulfill the reimbursement program guidelines.

Recipients will be notified after application has been reviewed.

Recipients not completing the following requirements by May 31, 2024 will not be reimbursed.

Reimbursement Process

1. Fill out the reimbursement request form & teacher evaluation form.
2. Have students fill out online survey.

3. Attach ALL receipts for beef related purchases.
4. Include how you used beef in your lesson plan (i.e. did you just use IBC's presentation or did you add your own twist to it as well).
5. Include at least 3 photos! (Ex: Picture of teacher or student cooking the beef or picture of students eating the beef).
6. Fill out the photo release form. We would love to use your photos (with permission) on our social medias, as examples for prospective teachers, and to show program success to the Indiana Beef Council board members.

Other Guidelines

- This program is not meant to support after school activities. It is for educational purposes ONLY. If the Indiana Beef Council feels that it did not go towards education at any point in the process, then they have the right to deny you the grant funding.
- **The beef may not be donated to your program**

-Please note only a limited amount of grants will be given out. It is a first come first serve basis-

Once all forms are received, a check will be sent reimbursing up to \$100.
